

LittoClarvinyl

Treatment of bitter substances and off-tastes

Characterization: LittoClarvinyl is a powder product on the basis of pvpp and milk casein combined with aluminium silicates and cellulose.

The effect is caused by the synergism of the ingredients intensifying the effect of the single components. LittoClarvinyl selectively removes various undesirable off-tastes and off-odours, but also phenolic components which cause bitter taste, as well as oxidizing off-flavours. Variations in sensory characteristics due to the vintage, can be balanced. LittoClarvinyl settles in the form of a solid deposit, there are no problems with over-finishing and the organoleptic feature of the wine is not negatively affected.

Oenological properties:

- Removes green and bitter flavours (particularly in red wines)
- Preventive and curative treatment of oxidation disorders
- Rounding off wines by balancing correction of taste and odour

Dosage:

Dissolve in a 10-fold amount of water and allow to swell for 1 - 2 hours. Add to the vessel under thorough stirring to distribute evenly.

White and rosé wines:

- preventive: 20 - 40 g/100 L (with damaged grapes the dosage can be increased to 60 – 70 g/100 L)
- curative: up to 100 g/100 L

Red wines: 10 – 20 g/100 L

Maximum admitted by EU-law = 400 g/100 L

The oenologist advises:

Ideal treatment of white and rosé wines from damaged or stressed grape harvest. Application is possible in grape must or wine. Red wines which have undergone strong extraction or are derived from unripe grapes can be treated in an optimal way. Please conduct pretests on an experimental scale.

Packaging:

1 kg plastic jar.

Storage:

LittoClarvinyl has to be protected from foreign smells and moisture. Store in a cool, dry and well-ventilated place free from foreign odours. Reseal opened packagings immediately and tightly (airtight). For improper storage and application liability is excluded.
